Jason Kravotil is Head of Policy and External Affairs at SentiLink, where he leads federal government engagement, corporate PR, and go-to-market strategy with a focus on government agency partnerships. A recognized expert in identity fraud, payments, data security, and consumer privacy, he has testified before Congress and serves as Chair of the Fairfax County Consumer Protection Commission and on the Board of Directors of the Identity Theft Resource Center. His career spans financial policy, law, and government: he was a principal at Sivon, Natter & Wechsler, where he founded the Consumer First Coalition and led efforts to build a real-time SSN verification service with the Social Security Administration; led the payments, technology, and cybersecurity practice at the Financial Services Roundtable; held policy roles at the American Bankers Association and Independent Community Bankers of America; and served six years as Legislative Director for Rep. Steven C. LaTourette (OH-14), focusing on consumer protection and data security with the House Financial Services Committee. He holds a Master of Public Policy from George Mason University, two B.A. degrees from Miami University (OH), and a CIPP/US certification.
